

Used Clothing Supplier YIKAO Expands Global Access With 20kg Trial Orders

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GUANGZHOU, CHINA — August 2026 — YIKAO Rewear Supply, a China-based used clothing supplier, is expanding its wholesale sourcing model to make second-hand clothing more accessible to small resellers, thrift businesses, wholesalers and international importers through trial orders starting from 20kg.

Traditionally, international used clothing sourcing has often been associated with large bale quantities or full-container purchases. For smaller buyers entering the second-hand clothing market, committing to a large shipment before testing product quality and local customer demand can create significant purchasing risk.

YIKAO's flexible sourcing model is designed to address this challenge by allowing selected customers to begin with smaller trial quantities before progressing toward larger wholesale and container orders.

"Many new buyers want to enter the used clothing business but are not ready to purchase a full container for their first order," said a representative of YIKAO Rewear Supply. "Our goal is to provide a more practical starting point so buyers can evaluate product categories, quality, shipping costs and local resale demand before increasing their purchasing volume."

Supporting Both Small Buyers and Large Importers

As an international used clothing supplier, YIKAO supplies sorted second-hand clothing, used shoes, used bags and reusable textile products for resale markets.

Product categories include men's, women's and children's used clothing as well as used jeans, T-

shirts, dresses, jackets, sweaters and mixed clothing bales. Used shoes and used bags can also be supplied according to customer requirements.

Buyers can discuss product category, quality grade, bale weight, packing method and order quantity according to their target market.

While smaller trial orders provide an entry point for new businesses, YIKAO also supports established wholesalers and importers purchasing in larger volumes, including 20-foot and 40-foot container shipments.

This combination allows buyers to move from market testing to larger-scale sourcing while continuing to work with the same supply channel.

Used Clothing Prepared for Different International Markets

Demand for second-hand clothing varies considerably between countries and regions.

Climate, consumer purchasing power, local fashion preferences and resale channels can all influence which categories perform well in a particular market.

YIKAO currently works with buyers serving markets including Africa, Southeast Asia, the Middle East and South America.

Rather than offering only a fixed product mix, the company works with importers and wholesalers to discuss clothing categories, grades, bale weights and packing configurations according to the needs of their destination market.

For example, buyers operating in warmer climates may prioritize lightweight T-shirts, dresses, shirts, skirts, shorts and trousers, while other markets may have stronger demand for jeans, jackets, children's clothing, shoes or bags.

This market-oriented approach is intended to help importers build product mixes that better match their local resale channels.

From Sorting to Container Loading

The international second-hand clothing trade depends not only on product availability but also on consistency in sorting, packing and shipment preparation.

YIKAO's wholesale process covers the collection, sorting, packing and export preparation of used clothing and other reusable goods.

Before placing larger orders, buyers can discuss specifications including product categories,

grade requirements, bale sizes, packaging and loading plans.

For container buyers, the company provides support for both 20-foot and 40-foot shipments, enabling established wholesalers and distributors to source larger quantities of second-hand clothing for their local markets.

Supporting the Growing Reuse Economy

The global second-hand clothing industry extends the usable life of garments, shoes and bags by moving reusable products into markets where they can continue to serve consumers.

For wholesalers and local resellers, used clothing also provides access to inventory at price points different from newly manufactured garments.

YIKAO sees flexible purchasing as an important part of expanding participation in this market.

By supporting both smaller trial purchases and traditional container-scale wholesale orders, the company aims to serve buyers at different stages of business development—from first-time resellers testing demand to experienced importers managing established distribution networks.

“We want customers to have the flexibility to start at a level that makes sense for their business,” the company representative added. “A buyer may start with a small shipment, understand what sells in their market and then gradually move toward larger bale or container orders.”
