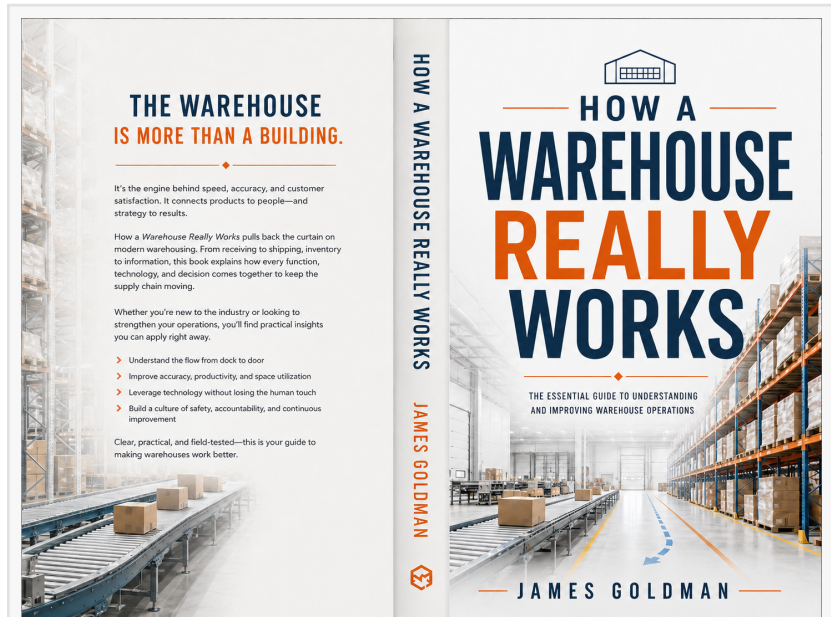

replenishment, picking, packing, staging, shipping and returns. It also examines labor, safety, operational leadership, warehouse technology, performance measurement, and the

dependencies connecting each part of the operation.

The book is designed to help instructors connect warehouse theory with the realities of day-to-day execution. It may be used as a classroom resource, supplemental text, professional-development guide or foundation for discussions about logistics, distribution, supply chain management, and warehouse systems.

“Many students enter supply chain programs without ever having seen how a warehouse operates as a complete system,” Goldman said. “My goal was to create a practical resource that helps educators show students how the individual functions connect and why a decision made in one area can create consequences throughout the entire operation.”
