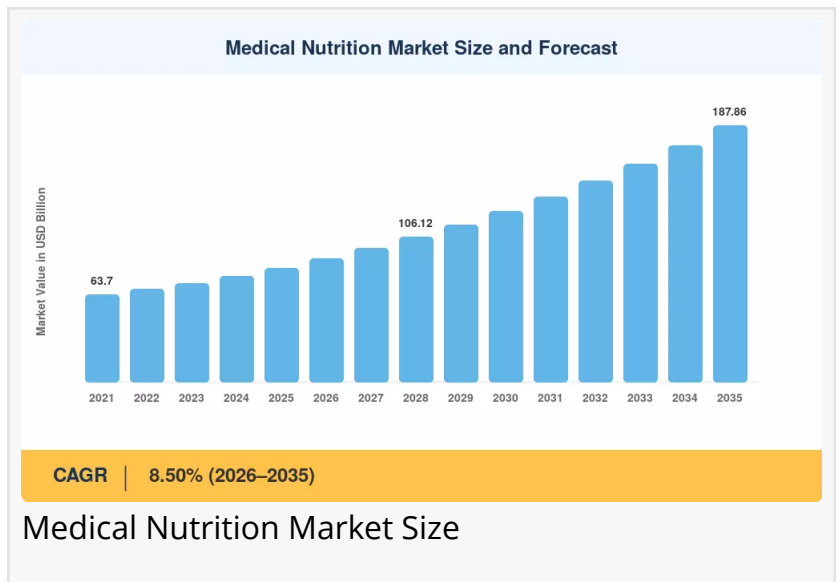


Medical Nutrition Market to reach USD 95.8 Billion by 2035 at 6.8% CAGR

Medical Nutrition Market to Surge from USD 49.8 Billion in 2025 to USD 95.8 Billion by 2035 — Powered by Aging Global Population, Rising Chronic Disease Burden
