According to the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles' 2025 Traffic Crash Facts report, Virginia recorded 115,858 traffic crashes in 2025, resulting in 825 fatalities and 74,194 injuries. While total crashes and fatalities each declined from 2024 to 2025, the number of people injured in Virginia crashes rose by 15.8% over the same period. The report also recorded 2,670 large truck crashes in 2025, including 45 fatal crashes that resulted in 10 deaths and nearly 500 injuries to truck occupants.
