Employee ownership shapes how Cascade invests in career development, shares business results with the people who generate them, and chooses the work it takes on.

Cascade's recognition also reflects employee-led community engagement. Across Cascade our staff volunteers with high school tech summit days and champion Cascade's partnership with iUrban Teen, which connects students from underrepresented communities to careers in technology and engineering. These dedicated Cascadians also run Cascade's summer engineering internship program in Portland, where students work alongside Cascade engineers on energy projects.

Cascade's environmental impact runs through its client work. In 2025, the company delivered 978.6 GWh in energy savings for industrial and commercial clients, enough to power roughly 89,000 U.S. homes for a year. That result brings Cascade 76% of the way toward a long-term goal of 8,000 GWh saved by 2028, a target the company set to help ease mounting strain on the nation's power grids as demand accelerates.
