“We are proud of the score, but we do not believe a great workplace means being perfect,” said Alex Tieu, Co-Founder and CEO of JLG Lawyers. “It means listening, improving and creating real opportunities for people to build the careers they want.”

For attorneys, that means more than traditional advancement. JLG gives attorneys opportunities to build and lead their own teams, develop management and litigation skills, take on greater responsibility and increase their earning potential as they grow. At the same time, the firm emphasizes work-life balance and flexibility, with an open-door management approach that encourages attorneys and staff to speak candidly about workloads, professional goals and

challenges outside of work.

"We want attorneys to be able to become stronger lawyers, stronger leaders and higher earners without feeling that career growth has to come at the expense of their personal lives," Tieu said. "As attorneys develop here, they can build teams around themselves, expand their skill sets and create a much larger career path within the firm."

That same emphasis on internal development extends to staff. Employees have advanced into leadership positions, and some have pursued becoming licensed attorneys through California's Law Office Study Program, an alternative pathway that allows qualifying candidates to study under attorney supervision rather than attend traditional law school.

JLG supports participating employees while they continue working and earning an income, including structured study support, bar preparation simulations and study groups during the workweek.

"We represent employees every day, so we have to be willing to hold ourselves to a high standard as an employer," said Michael Jaurigue, Founder of JLG Lawyers. "That does not mean getting everything right every time. It means hearing our people, working with them and being willing to change policies and procedures when there is a better way."

Great Place To Work Certification is based entirely on employee feedback collected through the Trust Index survey and is used in determining eligibility for the Fortune Best Workplaces lists.
