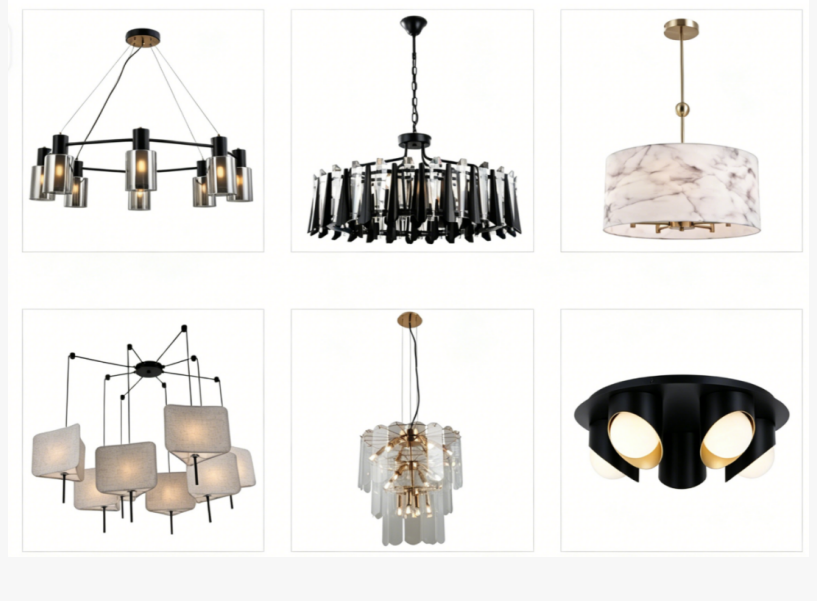


How Can a China Small Batch MOQ Hanging Lights Factory Benefit Boutique Wholesalers? Strong Lighting Explores

Q1: What Does a Small Batch MOQ Strategy Entail and How Does It Benefit Commercial Sourcing?

operational parameters. These initial prototypes are billed at double the baseline manufacturing cost to cover specialized tooling setup, with the premium credited back to the customer upon subsequent bulk order placement.

□Production Scheduling: Following final confirmation of the prototype, the order proceeds to the factory floor, which encompasses a 1,000-square-meter workshop equipped with two operational assembly lines.

□Fulfillment & Logistics: The complete manufacturing, wiring, and packaging cycle is concluded within a 45-to-60-day delivery window. To protect buyers against potential transit damage to fragile components, every bulk container includes an extra 2% allocation of glass parts as standard spare stock.

Q2: Does Low-Volume Sourcing Restrict a Wholesaler's Access to Diverse Product Portfolios?

A common concern among purchasing managers is that utilizing small-batch production lines might limit access to wide product selections or complex material combinations. Data from the extensive portfolio at Strong Lighting demonstrates that low-volume manufacturing can coexist with substantial design variation. The company maintains an active catalog of more than 3,000 unique Stock Keeping Units (SKUs), which grows by an average of eight new design series every month to reflect current trends in art, architecture, and interior design.
