

All Dogs Unleashed Frisco Includes Multi-Hour Family Training Session With Every Board & Train Graduation

Frisco facility's "Go-Home Day" process trains owners on commands, consistency, and household rules before any dog leaves the program.

FRISCO, TX, UNITED STATES, August 18, 2026 /EINPresswire.com/ -- When a dog completes the two-week Board & Train program at [All Dogs Unleashed](#) in Frisco, the final day is not a simple pickup. The facility schedules a dedicated family training session lasting several hours in which trainers walk every household member through the exact commands, handling techniques, and behavioral expectations the dog learned during the program. The company calls it "Go-Home Day," and the Frisco team treats it as one of the most consequential steps in the entire training process.

The owner education component addresses a well-documented challenge in the professional dog training industry: behavior regression after a dog returns to its home environment. Dogs often learn new skills quickly under professional guidance, but those skills can deteriorate within weeks if family members apply commands inconsistently, send mixed signals, or revert to old interaction patterns. By spending hours with each family before the dog leaves the facility, the All Dogs Unleashed Frisco team works to close that gap on day one.

"We do not hand a leash back and wave goodbye," said César Rosa, Director of Training at [All Dogs Unleashed in Frisco, TX](#). "Every family member who interacts with the dog gets hands-on practice with every command. We stay until the household is confident, because a trained dog paired with an unprepared owner is a regression waiting to happen."

During Go-Home Day sessions, trainers demonstrate each command the dog mastered,

including recall, heel, sit/stay at a distance, place command, and boundary respect, then coach the owner through live repetitions. The session covers leash handling mechanics, voice tone and timing, how to reinforce boundaries without confusion, and how to manage common household triggers like doorbell arrivals and meal preparation. Families with children receive specific guidance on age-appropriate interaction rules that maintain training consistency without overwhelming younger household members.

The methodology reflects a core principle in the All Dogs Unleashed training philosophy: the program teaches dogs to self-regulate rather than relying on constant owner correction. Co-founder and CEO Brian Claeys, a world champion sport-dog trainer who has guided more than 4,000 dogs through training, developed the approach alongside co-founder and President Travis Lux, winner of the 2016 PSA National Championship for obedience and training. Their method is designed so that trained behaviors persist even when the owner is not directly supervising the dog, but only when the household maintains consistent structure after graduation.

That post-graduation support extends well beyond Go-Home Day. Every Board & Train graduate at the Frisco location receives lifetime follow-up support, including refresher consultations and behavioral guidance as the dog moves through different life stages. The Frisco facility also offers a split-payment, money-back guarantee structure: backed by a split-payment, money-back guarantee.

The Frisco location, situated at 6136 Frisco Square Blvd Ste 400, serves families across Collin County neighborhoods including Phillips Creek Ranch, Newman Village, Richwoods, Starwood, and Stonebriar. The facility operates with indoor, climate-controlled training areas, a necessity in a region where summer temperatures regularly exceed 100 degrees, and provides free pickup and delivery for enrolled dogs.

Frisco's population has reached approximately 247,000 residents as of mid-2026, with the city growing at roughly 3.4 percent annually. New residential construction continues across the municipality, which remains only about 87 percent developed with a projected build-out population near 330,000. That growth means a steady influx of new dog-owning households navigating training decisions for the first time in the community.
