"We saw an opportunity to create a more connected operation where a brand can have one logistics partner involved from the time inventory is moving toward the warehouse all the way through fulfillment and final outbound shipping."

Paragon's Orlando fulfillment operation is designed to provide that end-to-end support.

The company can coordinate inbound LTL and FTL freight into its fulfillment operation, receive and manage inventory, store products, process ecommerce orders, provide pick-and-pack services, and coordinate parcel shipments to customers throughout the United States.

For brands selling through multiple channels, Paragon also supports B2B and wholesale fulfillment. This can include preparing case or pallet shipments and coordinating LTL transportation to retailers, distributors, and other commercial destinations.

The company has also added Amazon FBA preparation capabilities for ecommerce brands that need inventory labeled, prepared, consolidated, and shipped into Amazon's fulfillment network.

By combining freight transportation and fulfillment capabilities, Paragon aims to give growing businesses a single point of contact for more of their logistics operation.

For example, a Florida ecommerce company receiving palletized inventory from a manufacturer can use Paragon

to coordinate the inbound freight, receive and store the products in Orlando, fulfill direct-to-consumer orders, prepare wholesale shipments, and arrange LTL transportation when larger quantities need to move.

The Orlando location also provides a strategic Central Florida option for brands seeking fulfillment operations within the state. In addition to serving Florida customers, orders can be shipped nationwide through major parcel and freight carriers.

Paragon's fulfillment services include receiving, warehousing, inventory management, pick and pack, labeling, kitting, returns processing, B2B fulfillment, Amazon FBA preparation, parcel shipping coordination, and LTL and FTL transportation.

The company also works with brands that require more specialized fulfillment workflows.

Rather than operating solely as a traditional warehouse or freight brokerage, Paragon's model is intended to connect the transportation and fulfillment sides of a customer's supply chain.

"If a customer needs an LTL shipment brought into the warehouse, hundreds of ecommerce orders shipped individually, and then several pallets sent to a retailer or Amazon, we can help coordinate all of it. The goal is to make logistics simpler for growing brands."
