Facial veins often appear as small red, purple, or blue vessels near the skin’s surface, commonly around the nose, cheeks, chin, or under-eye area. Genetics, sun exposure, aging, rosacea, hormonal changes,

environmental damage, and repeated skin irritation may all contribute to visible facial vessels.

Although facial veins are often harmless, many patients seek treatment for cosmetic reasons and improved confidence. Laser vein removal uses focused light energy to target unwanted blood vessels beneath the skin. The laser heats the vessel while leaving surrounding tissue largely unaffected, and the body gradually absorbs the treated vessel over time.

“Visible facial veins can make the complexion appear uneven, and patients are often surprised to learn that treatment can be quick and noninvasive,” said [Dr. Amanda Cooper](#). “A personalized consultation helps determine which laser approach is best suited for the patient’s skin and vein concerns.”

The Evo Laser is designed to target small facial vessels, including broken capillaries around the nose and cheeks, and includes integrated cooling technology for patient comfort. Pico Laser technology delivers rapid bursts of laser energy in ultra-short durations to help break apart unwanted facial vessels.

The most appropriate laser system may depend on the size, depth, location, and appearance of the veins being treated, as well as the patient’s skin type and overall goals.

Each patient begins with a consultation and skin assessment. During treatment, the laser device is applied to the target area to address visible vessels. Patients may feel brief warmth or a snapping sensation, and cooling technology may be used to improve comfort. Mild redness or swelling can occur temporarily, but many patients return to normal daily activities shortly after treatment.

Some patients may need multiple sessions to achieve their desired improvement. Results develop gradually as the body reabsorbs the treated vessels over several weeks. While treated veins are typically removed, new facial veins may develop over time due to aging, genetics, sun exposure, or other factors.
