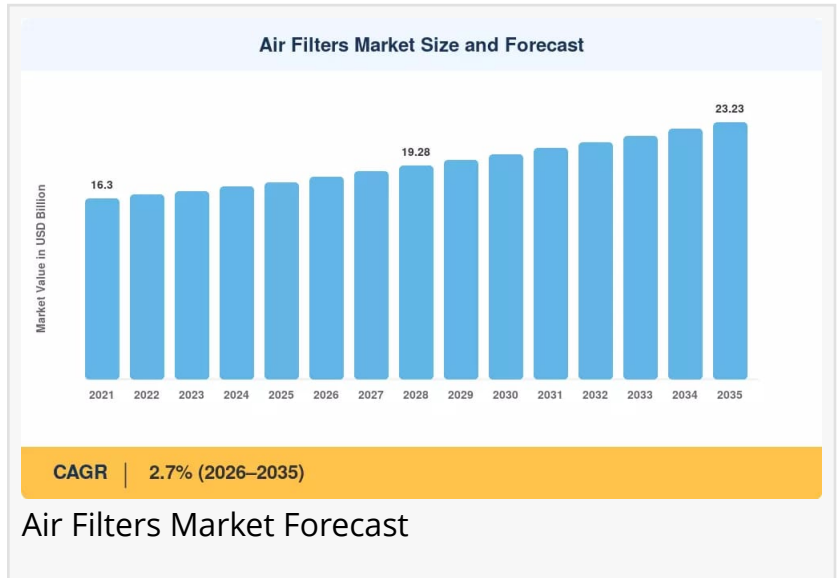


Air Filters Market Outlook Strengthens as Demand for Cleaner Air Supports 2.7% CAGR Through 2035
