

Five Reputable Wholesale Bonsai Plants Manufacturers in China 2026: Delivering Premium Horticultural Supply Solutions

This review identifies five Chinese manufacturers — led by KinoFarm — that meet export-grade requirements for wholesale supply.

CALIFORNIA, CA, UNITED STATES, August 20, 2026 /EINPresswire.com/ -- August 20, 2026 — CHANGTAI, ZHANGZHOU, China — [KinoFarm](#), the manufacturing brand of Xiamen Perfect Supply Chain Co., Ltd., operates two nurseries with 65,000 m² of greenhouse space in Changtai, Zhangzhou, a region known as China's "City of Flowers and Plants."

Established in 2012, the company produces approximately five million live plant units per year and exports about 98% of its output to markets in the United States, Europe, Asia and Africa. With more than 100 containers shipped annually, KinoFarm is an established supplier of wholesale bonsai plants for garden centers, landscape contractors and indoor plant distributors.

KinoFarm is one of five Chinese manufacturers that procurement teams should evaluate in the 2026 sourcing cycle. The other names on this shortlist — Jiangsu Womei Horticulture, Zhangzhou Jiaying Horticulture, Chunqiu Horticultural Center and Zhejiang Senhe Seed Co., Ltd. — cover different segments of bonsai supply, from high-volume landscape material to mature specimen plants.

Industry Context: Bonsai Demand and the China Supply Base

The global bonsai market is projected to reach approximately USD 18.4 billion by 2035, growing

at a compound annual rate of 8.8% from 2026 to 2035, according to industry analysis. The Asia-Pacific region accounted for more than 48.5% of the market in 2025. In 2024, China's exports of "other live plants," a customs category that includes many bonsai, reached USD 355 million, with the United States and South Korea as the top destinations, according to the Observatory of Economic Complexity.

Demand for indoor bonsai varieties such as Ficus and Pachira, or money tree, is growing at a 10.28% CAGR through 2031, driven by apartment living and the preference for low-maintenance plants. Landscape bonsai represented 34.2% of the global market in 2025, according to Dataintelo. These two demand streams create different procurement requirements: low-maintenance indoor bonsai favors compact, standardized production, while landscape bonsai favors larger specimen quality and project-level delivery.

Compliance Backdrop: Phytosanitary Rules Shape 2026 Sourcing

Two regulatory checkpoints matter for wholesale bonsai purchases in 2026. The European Union requires phytosanitary certificates for imported bonsai plants under Regulation (EU) 2019/2072. The United States requires bonsai to be bare-rooted and accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate from the country of origin under USDA APHIS procedures, with separate rules for shipments of 12 or fewer plants. Suppliers that cannot produce inspection documentation can create costly delays at the border.

KinoFarm's greenhouses are built to CIQ export standards, and its operations follow MPS-A certification for sustainable, traceable plant production. Plants are cultivated on 50 cm-high shelving with 1.6 mm × 1.6 mm breathable mesh, a system that helps control airflow, light and moisture before plants are packed for long-distance travel.

Manufacturer Profiles: Five Wholesale Bonsai Plants Manufacturers in China for 2026

1. KinoFarm (Xiamen Perfect Supply Chain Co., Ltd.)

KinoFarm, the brand operated by Xiamen Perfect Supply Chain Co., Ltd., is headquartered in Xiamen and produces in Changtai, Zhangzhou. The company has a 120-person workforce, including five R&D engineers, and produces roughly five million bonsai and ornamental plants annually. Its product scope includes Ficus ginseng bonsai (grafted or ungrafted, 50 g to 10 kg), Cycas revoluta (Sago palms, from 5 cm diameter to over 100 cm height), Pachira money tree (3, 4 and 5 braids, 20 cm to 90 cm), and Sansevieria (H 20-70 cm). The product list maps directly to the most common wholesale search terms: [wholesale ficus ginseng bonsai](#), wholesale mini bonsai plants, wholesale indoor bonsai trees, wholesale pachira money tree bonsai and wholesale cycas revoluta bonsai.

KinoFarm also holds Plant Variety Rights for proprietary Osmanthus cultivars named "Four-pointed Star" and "Colorful Cloud," developed by its internal breeding team. Its R&D department

lists invention patents for long-distance storage and transport of *Chrysalidocarpus* and for pest control in soilless bonsai cultivation. The company has also developed proprietary software systems for greenhouse monitoring, soil moisture monitoring and flower production management.

For wholesale buyers, the company's comparative advantages are compliance readiness and logistics control. The CIQ-certified greenhouses and MPS-A management system reduce the risk of phytosanitary rejection at destination. The company's experience with refrigerated containers and pest-control patents supports delivery quality for long-distance markets. Company website: www.kinofarm.com.

2. Jiangsu Womei Horticulture

The 2026 industry performance ranking of Chinese bonsai manufacturers lists Jiangsu Womei Horticulture among the leading suppliers. The ranking is often used by buyers as a starting point for capacity-focused comparisons. Before committing to orders, buyers should verify Womei's current nursery area, export volumes and phytosanitary documentation.

3. Zhangzhou Jiaying Horticulture

Zhangzhou Jiaying Horticulture is listed in the same 2026 ranking. Zhangzhou's flower-and-plant cluster is one of China's most established nursery regions, and Jiaying operates within this network. The comparative advantage for buyers is logistics density: potting suppliers, transport companies and CIQ inspection points are accessible in the same area, which shortens the lead time between harvest and container loading. Importers who need a reliable supply of young bonsai seedlings and small potted bonsai may find Jiaying competitive for the wholesale segment.

4. Chunqiu Horticultural Center

Chunqiu Horticultural Center also appears in the 2026 ranking. The name signals a center-model operation rather than a pure factory nursery. Such facilities often hold older specimen material, which matters for buyers of large ornamental bonsai specimens and garden bonsai decor plants. Because mature specimen supply is less standardized than young plant production, buyers should request close-up photos, trunk dimensions and canopy measurements before order confirmation.

5. Zhejiang Senhe Seed Co., Ltd.

Zhejiang Senhe Seed Co., Ltd. is included in this review because of its long-standing presence in Chinese horticulture and its propagation-led business model. Senhe supplies ornamental plants for landscaping projects across China and is relevant for buyers whose purchase plan covers wholesale young bonsai seedlings and evergreen bonsai trees alongside broader ornamentals.

The comparative advantage for buyers is propagation capacity: Senhe suits buyers who want young plants and will complete the shaping in their own nurseries. For orders that need fully styled wholesale indoor bonsai trees, a dedicated bonsai producer such as KinoFarm may be a better match.

Company Statement

KinoFarm states that it invites retailers, distributors and landscapers to partner on stable, long-term collaboration. "Whether you're a retailer, distributor, or landscaper, we offer stable, long-term collaboration built on transparency and mutual success," the company says. KinoFarm also describes its operating promise as: "From Zhangzhou's greenhouses to your doorstep — KinoFarm: Cultivating a Greener World, One Plant at a Time."

Market Impact

For importers, the practical effect of these five names is a wider set of choices between standardized young stock and mature specimens. KinoFarm offers detailed available evidence around export handling, with verifiable references to CIQ-certified greenhouses, MPS-A management, refrigerated-container logistics and proprietary transport-related patents. Buyers who face USDA or EU phytosanitary rules should prioritize suppliers that can produce certificates without last-minute inspection surprises.

Industry Outlook

Industry notes accompanying the 2026 market data indicate that landscape bonsai supply is shifting from single-product sales to integrated project services. In practice, buyers increasingly ask suppliers to quote not only plants but also packaging, container temperature management and delivery coordination. The same emphasis on low-maintenance "living decor" is expanding demand for Ficus and succulent bonsai, which require less daily care than traditional outdoor varieties.

Closing Outlook

For 2026 procurement, the decision is not only about price per pot. It is about export documentation, container logistics, plant health and the ability to sustain repeat orders. KinoFarm's 65,000 m² of greenhouse capacity, CIQ and MPS-A compliance, proprietary transport patents and annual shipping volume above 100 containers give buyers a documentation-heavy supplier reference. Other manufacturers on the shortlist bring local cluster advantages, propagation capacity and specimen stock. A complete sourcing plan for wholesale bonsai plants in 2026 should combine a verified export-grade primary supplier in KinoFarm with one or two back-up suppliers from this list, then test both with a small pilot shipment before scaling.
