Autism is a developmental disorder that affects social interaction and communication, making diagnosis and intervention critical. This growing prevalence significantly contributes to the expansion of the pediatric neurology device market.

Increasing Pediatric Patient Numbers Supporting Market Growth

Another crucial driver for the pediatric neurology device market is the rising population of pediatric patients. Typically defined as individuals below the age of 15 or 21 depending on the jurisdiction, pediatric patients have distinct medical needs as their bodies and brains develop. Devices tailored for this group assist in diagnosing and treating neurological issues including stroke, seizures, hydrocephalus, and oncology-related conditions. For instance, in March 2024, data from the UK's Office for Health Improvement & Disparities revealed that the number of children in care under 18 increased to 71 per 100,000 in 2023 from 70 per 100,000 in 2022. Higher rates were observed among older age groups, with 168 per 100,000 for those aged 16 to 17 and 76 per 100,000 for ages 10 to 15. This increase in pediatric patient numbers is a significant factor driving demand for pediatric neurology devices.
