

Arizona's Population Boom Is Driving Record Demand for Local Movers, Says Dose Moving & Storage

As Maricopa County continues to lead the nation in population growth, Dose Moving & Storage reports rising demand for local and long-distance moving services.

The Numbers Behind the Growth

Maricopa County's population reached 4,673,096 as of July 2024, up from 4,585,871 the year prior, continuing a trend that has made it one of the nation's fastest-growing counties for years. The broader Phoenix metro area added roughly 92,100 residents in a recent 12-month period, with net migration remaining the primary driver of growth across the region rather than births alone.

That growth is not limited to any single part of the Valley. Fast-growing cities including Mesa,

Gilbert, Chandler, Buckeye, and Queen Creek have each seen significant population gains in recent years, and each is generating steady moving demand of its own. For a company built on flat-rate pricing and in-house crews, that kind of sustained, spread-out growth requires the ability to scale service across the entire metro rather than concentrating resources in one part of town.

Why People Are Moving to Arizona

Dose Moving & Storage says the drivers behind its growing customer base mirror broader trends reported by state and county data: relocation for work, more affordable housing than coastal markets, and retirees and snowbirds choosing Arizona for its climate and lifestyle. Many of these transplants are coming from California, Washington, and other higher-cost states, drawn by lower housing costs and a lower overall cost of living relative to their home markets.

The company has also seen a corresponding increase in interstate relocations, with [long-distance movers Arizona](#) residents rely on seeing sustained demand from families and individuals relocating into the state from across the country. On the business side, the company has seen a parallel uptick in commercial moves as companies expand into the Valley alongside the residential boom, drawn by Arizona's lower cost of doing business and growing workforce.

Meeting Demand With Flat-Rate, In-House Service

As demand increases, Dose Moving & Storage says its business model, owning its trucks and employing its own crews rather than brokering jobs to third-party carriers, has allowed it to scale without sacrificing the consistency that has earned the company a 4.8-star rating across 958 Google reviews. Brokered moves, in which a company sells a job to a separate carrier rather than performing it directly, are a common source of customer complaints in a fast-growing market where demand can outpace legitimate capacity. By keeping its trucks and crews in-house, Dose Moving & Storage says it is able to maintain quality control even as volume increases.

As a [flat-rate moving company Phoenix](#) customers have increasingly turned to during this growth period, Dose Moving & Storage offers upfront, transparent pricing on local, residential, commercial, long-distance, packing, and storage services throughout the Phoenix metro and beyond, removing the uncertainty of hourly billing that can leave customers with unexpected

Looking Ahead

With Arizona's population growth expected to continue in the years ahead, Dose Moving & Storage says it is investing in additional crews, trucks, and capacity to keep pace with demand across its Phoenix and Mesa service areas. The company says its priority is to grow at a pace that allows it to maintain the same flat-rate pricing model and hands-on service standards it was built on in 2014, rather than expanding in ways that would require it to rely on outside carriers or subcontracted labor.

"We've watched this growth happen in real time. Every year we get more calls from families relocating from California, from businesses expanding into the Valley, from retirees making Arizona home," said Jason Dose, founder of Dose Moving & Storage. "Our job is to make sure that growth doesn't come with the chaos people expect from a move. That's why we stayed flat-rate and kept everything in-house."
