Founded in 1998, Discovering Justice pairs volunteer attorneys with middle school students for an 11-week Mock Trial program, teaching case analysis, persuasive argument, and courtroom procedure before students argue their cases before real judges and community juries. Sam Raphael's mentorship was coordinated in partnership with the Plymouth County Bar Association — an organization Bruce S. Raphael served as president in 2020 and continues to serve as past president.
