It is the company's second consecutive year on Inc. magazine's ranking of America's fastest-growing private companies, up from No. 3,286 in 2025 - a climb of 1,637 positions.

"Growth in ingredient supply is not something you announce - it is something your customers renew," said Ricardo Esmeraldino, founder of New Acai Amazonas. "Manufacturers stay with a supplier when the material is consistent, the paperwork is complete and the delivery lands when their production schedule says it must. Climbing 1,600 places on the Inc. 5000 tells us we got that right two years in a row."

New Acai Amazonas supplies bulk organic acai, acerola, camu camu, cupuacu, pitaya, maqui berry and guarana - as freeze-dried powders, spray-dried powders, juice powders, standardized extracts and evaporated (RWD) acai - to food, beverage, nutraceutical and cosmetic manufacturers worldwide. Its ingredients are sourced farm-direct from a dedicated 3,500-acre certified organic farm in Obidos, Para, in the heart of the Brazilian Amazon, where fruit is

processed as soon as three hours after harvest.

The company's growth has been built on supply reliability and documentation rather than on distribution breadth. It holds USDA-NOP organic certification (NOP ID 6220008042) with recognized US-EU, US-Canada and US-Japan organic equivalence, publicly verifiable in the USDA Organic INTEGRITY database. At origin, its [organic acai and acerola are certified to Regulation \(EU\) 2018/848](#) by control body ECOCERT SAS (EU code BR-BIO-154), verifiable in the European Commission's TRACES directory. The range is also Kosher and Non-GMO, produced under GFSI-certified food-safety management, and imported by an FSVP-compliant US importer.

A 365-day inventory in Orlando, Florida ships in-stock lots within one to three business days nationwide, with made-to-order production running four to six weeks and programs supplying buyers in Europe and Asia. Every quote is dispatched with the specification sheet, a batch Certificate of Analysis stating test methods, allergen and Non-GMO statements, and organic certificates.

The Inc. 5000 ranks private American companies by three-year revenue growth. The 2026 class, announced on August 11, 2026, collectively generated more than \$385 billion in revenue and accounted for over 627,000 jobs.
