

Custom Apron UK Expands Personalised Apron Collection for Hospitality, Trade and Creative Professionals

Ashington-based retailer offers made-to-order leather, canvas and denim aprons with logo, name and embroidery options for chefs, barbers and more.

ASHINGTON, NORTHUMBERLAND, UNITED KINGDOM, August 23, 2026 /EINPresswire.com/ -- [Custom Apron UK](#), a personalised workwear retailer based in Ashington, Northumberland, has expanded its catalogue of made-to-order aprons designed for professionals and hobbyists across the hospitality, trade and creative sectors. The company, which operates online at [customapron.co.uk](#), produces aprons in leather, canvas and denim, finished with customer-supplied logos, names or embroidered designs.

The expanded range spans categories including cooking, bartending, woodworking, blacksmithing, butchery, barista work, barbering and hairdressing, gardening, artist studios and general printed workwear. Each category is built around the practical demands of the trade it serves, from heat- and blade-resistant leather cuts for kitchen and bar staff to lighter canvas options suited to studio and garden work.

Customers begin the ordering process by selecting a material leather, canvas or denim along with quantity and a delivery deadline through an online quote form. The company states that its team responds to quote requests within 24 hours. Design options include embroidered logos, printed graphics, names and photo-based personalisation, allowing businesses to outfit staff in matching branded aprons or individuals to order a single personalised piece as a gift.

"Every apron we make is meant to hold up to a full shift, whether that's behind a bar, at a woodworking bench or in front of a grill," said a spokesperson for the company. "Letting customers choose their own material, fit and branding means the apron works for the specific job it's being worn for, not just a generic one-size design."

The company's production process follows three stages publicised on its website: selecting an apron style suited to the customer's trade, submitting design details such as logo placement or embroidery text, and a final production and delivery stage. Aprons are shipped across the United Kingdom, and the company reports fast dispatch on in-stock styles.

Beyond apparel for working professionals, the retailer's product pages note that features such as

adjustable crossback straps, multiple tool pockets and reinforced stitching are built into its leather styles, which are aimed at users who need durability for repeated daily use. The company also lists eco-friendly material options within its range for customers seeking lower-impact alternatives to standard leather.

Customer support is available through live chat six days a week, and the company operates a 30-day return window on eligible orders. Its website also hosts a frequently-asked-questions section addressing common customer queries, such as apron terminology, sizing differences between bib and waist aprons, and the distinction between printed and embroidered personalisation.

[Custom Apron](#) UK's product catalogue is organised by trade category on its website, with dedicated sections for artists, bartenders, cooks, gardeners, blacksmiths, butchers, baristas, barbers and woodworkers, alongside a general printed-apron section for buyers who do not fit a single trade category. The company markets bulk ordering for businesses seeking uniform staff aprons alongside single-unit orders for individual buyers.

The company is headquartered at 158 Woodhorn Rd, Ashington, Northumberland, and maintains a presence on Instagram and Pinterest, where it shares completed designs and customer orders. It can also be reached by phone and email for quote enquiries, bulk orders and general customer service questions.

Custom Apron UK's site content indicates the business has operated since 2021, building a catalogue of trade-specific styles over that period while adding new product lines and material options. The company continues to publish guidance for customers on apron styles, materials and care through a blog section on its website, alongside the dedicated FAQ resource.

For businesses in hospitality, food service, trades and creative industries seeking uniform or branded workwear, the retailer positions its made-to-order model — pairing material choice with logo, name or embroidery customisation — as a way to standardise staff appearance while allowing for role-specific practical features such as tool pockets or adjustable straps.
