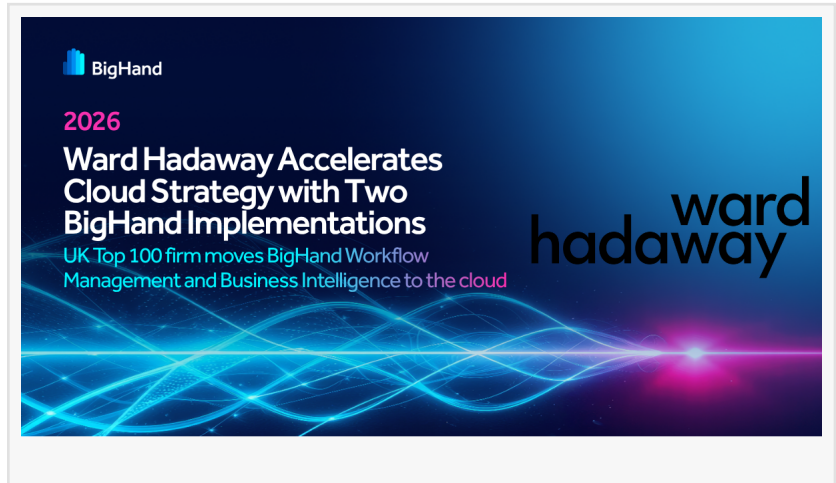


Ward Hadaway Accelerates Cloud Strategy with Two BigHand Implementations
