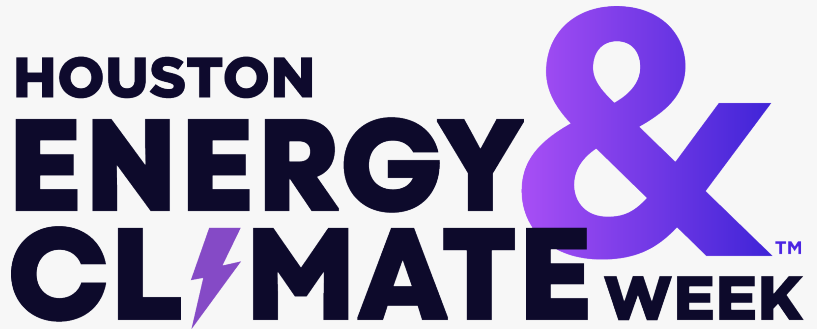


# Global Artist AY Young to Perform at Houston Energy & Climate Week

As a live-first entertainer building a global fan movement, Young's music serves as the heartbeat of his artistry. He is the creator of a growing catalog of original records built around hope, possibility, and action, songs explicitly created to move people. The Houston appearance marks a significant, artist-first chapter for Young, supporting his larger return to consistent music releases and national touring.

Young is also the founder of [Battery Tour](#), the world's longest-running clean-energy concert tour. Throughout his career, Young has performed more than 1,400 concerts and events globally. Of those performances, 963 have been powered by clean energy through Battery Tour. Having completed concert No. 963 in Denver, Colorado, Young is now a definitive 37 performances away from reaching his historic milestone. The Road to 1,000 is the global campaign that documents this journey and connects music, innovation, and fan participation.

Young's artistic and impact credentials have earned him global recognition, including being named by the United Nations as one of its 17 Young Leaders for the Sustainable Development

Goals.

"I'm coming to Houston first and foremost as an artist, but I've always believed music and culture can be a force for change," said AY Young. "Music is the heartbeat of everything I do. Battery Tour started with a simple question: could I power my own shows with clean energy? Nine hundred and sixty-three shows later, we're closing in on 1,000. Houston is a place that builds things, and I'm excited to bring the music here, meet people who are building what's next, and see what we can create together."

"Houston has always been a city where big ideas get built," said Katie Mehnert, co-founder of Houston Energy & Climate Week and CEO of The Bee Suite. "AY brings something different to that conversation. He's an artist who didn't just talk about an idea. He built it, took it on the road and has kept it going for nearly 1,000 shows. That combination of music, creativity and execution belongs at [Houston Energy & Climate Week](#)."

Houston represents the next major chapter in Young's live journey, serving as an important intersection where music, culture, energy, and innovation meet. Young will officially open [The Inaugural & Awards](#) on Sunday, September 13, at ARTECHOUSE Houston. Throughout the remainder of Houston Energy & Climate Week (HECW), he is expected to be active across multiple Houston venues. His week-long participation will blend live performances, storytelling, media, networking, and direct community engagement.
