The monitor includes English voice guidance, a large backlit display, one-button operation, a large adult upper arm cuff, and dual-user memory with up to 398 stored readings.

Unlike many connected health devices, the U80B does not require users to download an app, create an online account, connect via Bluetooth, or upload personal health information to a cloud platform to use the monitor. No forced app. No Bluetooth requirement. No cloud account. Local memory.

The U80B stores readings directly on the device, with two-user local memory that can store up to 199 readings per

user, for a total of 398 readings. This allows users and caregivers to keep a home record of blood pressure readings without relying on third-party platforms for basic device use.

“For many seniors and veterans, simplicity and privacy matter,” said Dr. Ezeonu. “They want a dependable device that helps them monitor their health without forcing them into an app or cloud-based system they do not need.”
