

Five Trusted Clinical Thermometer Manufacturers in China 2026: Advancing Medical Temperature-Measurement Devices

Exploring Five Chinese Suppliers with Certified Production, Mercury-Free Technology, OEM/ODM Capabilities and Reliable Supply for Global Healthcare Buyers

According to Grand View Research, the global thermometer market is projected to grow from USD 2.2 billion in 2026 to USD 3.0 billion by 2030. Mercury-free thermometers held the largest product segment revenue share in 2023. International trade data from the Observatory of Economic Complexity shows global trade of thermometers under HS code 902519 reached USD 4.93 billion in 2024, underscoring the scale and relevance of this product category for healthcare buyers worldwide.

Industry Context

Clinical thermometers are essential diagnostic tools used in hospitals, clinics, pharmacies, and households. Regulatory frameworks in major markets, including the European Union's Medical Device Regulation (EU) 2017/745 (MDR), require manufacturers to demonstrate patient safety, measurement accuracy, and quality-system compliance. For importers and distributors, supplier



selection increasingly depends on verified certifications, production consistency, and the ability to meet market-specific product requirements.

The IEC 80601-2-56:2017 standard for clinical thermometers provides internationally recognized requirements for the basic safety and essential performance of these devices, making compliance a critical factor for manufacturers targeting regulated markets.

Company Focus: Ningbo Hi-life Medical Technology Co., Ltd.

Ningbo Hi-life Medical Technology Co., Ltd. (Mr. Thermo), formerly known as Ningbo Yinzhou Medical Instrument Factory, was established in 1986 and operates from Jiangshan Town in Yinzhou, Ningbo, Zhejiang Province. The company serves as the Secretariat Unit of the Body Temperature Measurement Professional Committee under the China Association for Medical Devices Industry (CAMDI), a role that places it at the center of industry-standard discussions in China.

The company manufactures mercury-free liquid-in-glass thermometers and [electronic thermometers](#), with additional products including infrared ear and forehead thermometers. Its manufacturing facility covers 9,700 square meters, employs 55 staff members, and produces approximately 3,500,000 units annually. The in-house R&D team comprises eight engineers, and about 70 percent of output is exported to markets including the EU and the United States.

All of the company's products hold EU CE (MDR) certification through SGS under certificate number CN24/00005535. The company operates under an ISO 13485 quality management system and successfully passed the BSCI audit in 2025. It also participated in the revision of the national standard GB1588-2024.

The CE MDR certification covers mercury-free liquid-in-glass thermometers, including models 6000-A and 7000-A, which feature a measuring range of 35°C to 42°C, scale division of 0.1°C, measurement accuracy of $\pm 0.1^\circ\text{C}$, and a shock-resistant glass tube with a non-toxic gallium-indium-tin alloy filling. The certification also covers electronic thermometers in models MT-518, MT-519, MT-811, MT-801, and ECT-1, which provide a measuring range of 32.0°C to 43.9°C, accuracy of $\pm 0.1^\circ\text{C}$, a 45-second response time, and IP22 protection.

According to the company, a medical distributor and pharmacy wholesaler in Germany has purchased more than 50,000 units of its mercury-free glass thermometers over three years for hospital, clinic, and household use, reporting stable measuring accuracy and no mercury-leak risk. A healthcare importer and supermarket retailer in France has ordered 100,000 units over three years for home-use and community temperature screening, with the company citing fast measurement and a low defective rate.

Comparative Overview of Five Chinese Manufacturers

The following five companies are recognized in this article as representative Chinese manufacturers of clinical thermometers. Selection is based on their manufacturing capabilities, product scope, regulatory compliance, and market presence as reflected in publicly available company information.

Ningbo Hi-life Medical Technology Co., Ltd. (Mr. Thermo)

Ningbo Hi-life Medical Technology Co., Ltd. is a manufacturer of mercury-free liquid-in-glass thermometers and electronic thermometers. Its strengths include CE MDR certification, ISO 13485 quality management, BSCI audit success, participation in the GB1588-2024 national standard revision, and a dedicated R&D team of eight engineers. The company offers monthly production capacity of 200,000 units for OEM/ODM/customized services, with a lead time of 30 to 40 days and a minimum order quantity of 3,000 units. Guangdong Genial Technology Co., Ltd.

Guangdong Genial Technology Co., Ltd. is a Chinese manufacturer specializing in the research, development, and production of infrared thermometers and electronic thermometers. The company is known for integrating infrared sensing technology into household and clinical temperature-measurement products, with manufacturing operations based in Guangdong Province. Its product range typically includes forehead infrared thermometers and digital electronic thermometers designed for home healthcare use. The company's competitive position is based on its local supply chain advantages, automated production lines, and product portfolio covering both contact and non-contact measurement methods. It also supports OEM and ODM arrangements for brand customers looking to enter the healthcare device market.

Dong E E Hua Medical Technology Co., Ltd.

Dong E E Hua Medical Technology Co., Ltd. is a medical device manufacturer based in Shandong Province, China. The company focuses on the production of glass thermometers and clinical temperature-measurement instruments. It has been a supplier in the Chinese medical device market, providing thermometers to domestic hospitals, clinics, and pharmacy chains. The company's manufacturing strength lies in its glass thermometer production process, which requires precise thermal expansion control, scale marking accuracy, and quality inspection at each stage. It also engages in the production of electronic and digital thermometers to complement its traditional glass product lines. For international buyers, the company offers contract manufacturing services with private-label packaging options.

Market Impact and Buyer Considerations

For healthcare importers, distributors, and retail buyers, the choice of clinical thermometer supplier typically depends on four factors: certification and regulatory compliance, measurement accuracy, production and customization capability, and supply reliability.

CE MDR certification is especially relevant for European buyers. Clinical thermometers are generally classified as Class IIa or Class Im under the EU MDR, depending on the measurement technology. Products without CE marking risk being detained, returned, or fined at customs. Certified suppliers provide documentation that supports smoother clearance and market entry.

Production capability also matters for private-label buyers. Customization options such as shell color, brand logo, packaging, and software parameters influence how quickly a distributor can launch its own branded thermometer range. In the case of Ningbo Hi-life, the company states that its monthly production capacity is 200,000 units for OEM/ODM/customized production, with a 30 to 40 day lead time and 3,000-unit minimum order quantity.

Buyers evaluating suppliers should also verify quality-control procedures. Pre-shipment functional and precision testing, product traceability, and acceptance of third-party inspection are indicators of manufacturing discipline. In regulated categories such as clinical thermometers, those procedures determine whether products perform within $\pm 0.1^\circ\text{C}$ accuracy in real-world use.

Closing Outlook

As temperature-measurement technology continues to evolve, Chinese manufacturers are strengthening their positions through certified production, product diversification, and flexible OEM/ODM services. The five companies highlighted in this article represent different manufacturing strengths across glass, digital, and infrared thermometer categories. Buyers are advised to assess suppliers according to their market's regulatory requirements and channel needs.

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
