Allison recognizes that AI can have value during early-stage ideation, but she also believes the abundance of automatically generated imagery makes human creativity and discernment increasingly important.

At the same time, Allison views this technological shift as an opportunity for designers to place greater emphasis on craftsmanship, creative judgment, and strategic thinking. In an

environment where imagery can be produced rapidly and at scale, she believes human perspective and intentional design become even more valuable. The ability to understand context, communicate emotion, develop strong concepts, and create work with purpose remains central to effective visual storytelling.
