

LivDry Launches Hyper 2800, Its Highest-Capacity Incontinence Insert Yet

Independently tested under ISO 11948-1, the Hyper 2800 provides 4,034 mL of maximum laboratory-tested absorbent capacity for moderate to heavy incontinence

Independently tested under the internationally recognized ISO 11948-1 (Rothwell) standard, Hyper 2800 demonstrated a maximum laboratory-tested absorbent capacity of 4,034 mL (136 oz), or approximately 17 cups of liquid. The new insert extends LivDry's Hyper line with its highest level of absorbency for people and caregivers who need additional protection for [overnight](#) use or when involving limited mobility.

Not everyone living with bladder leakage has the same protection needs, and those needs can change over time. While lighter products may be appropriate for occasional leakage, people experiencing larger or more frequent urinary incontinence may require greater absorbency, expanded coverage and additional support during extended wear.

For individuals living with significant bladder leakage, and the caregivers who support them, effective protection can require more than a single product. Hyper 2800 is designed to be worn inside compatible protective underwear or briefs to add absorbency when standard protection alone may not be enough. This two-part approach can provide additional protection for overnight use, rehabilitation, periods of reduced mobility and other higher-demand care

situations while allowing users to maintain familiar products and routines. Additionally, the Hyper insert pad is easier for caregivers during changes, compared to pull-on style or tabbed briefs.

"The insights we gather from customers, caregivers and healthcare professionals continue to shape how we develop the Hyper line," said Ty Hishikawa, President of LiveDo USA. "As protection needs become more demanding, people need options that provide greater absorbency for comfort, fewer changes, and ease of caregiving. Hyper 2800 extends the range for individuals and caregivers looking for that additional level of protection."

Hyper 2800 combines a high absorbing top sheet to promote skin health with a core designed to draw in and distribute fluid throughout the insert. This super absorbent polymer core plus a soft top sheet and breathable materials help support comfort and a drier skin-facing surface during extended wear. Leakage control barriers around legs also helps contain fluid and limit side leaks.

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Insights we gather from consumers and caregivers shape how we develop the Hyper line. We recognize they need options offering greater absorbency for comfort, fewer changes, and ease of caregiving.”

With the launch of Hyper 2800, LivDry now offers five independently tested Hyper inserts with progressively higher absorbent capacities:

- Hyper 1200: 2,180 mL (74 oz)
- Hyper 1600: 2,432 mL (82 oz)

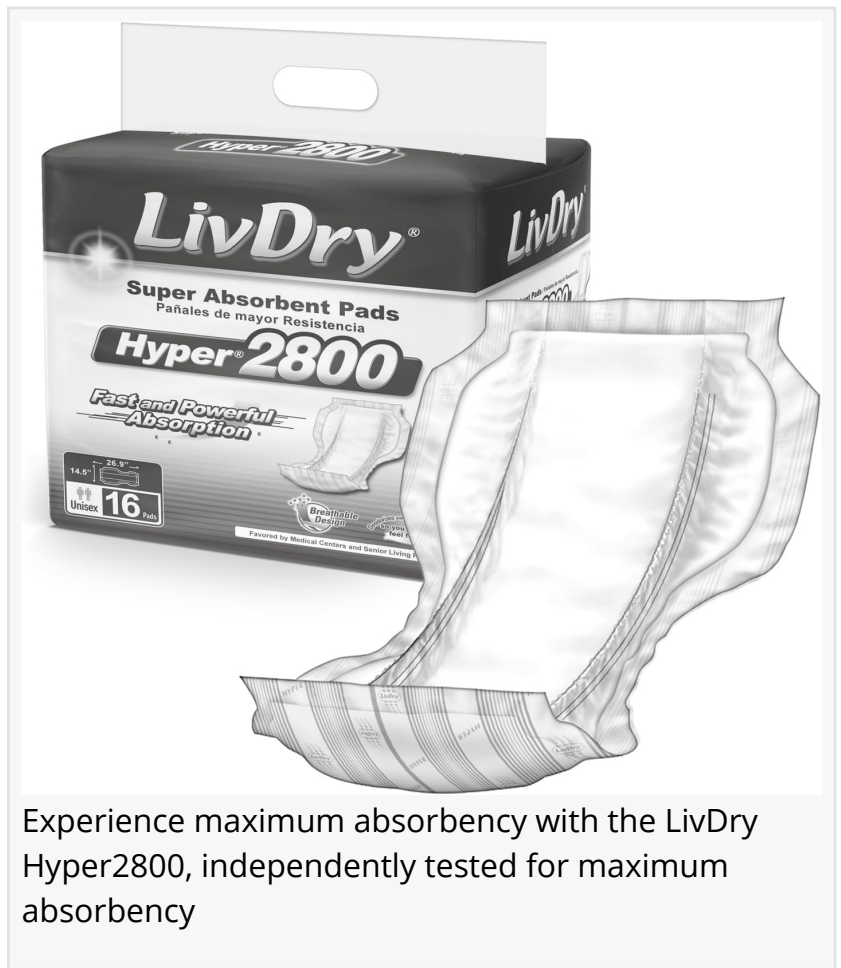

High-Capacity Protection Across Different Care Needs

LivDry's high-capacity protection options extend beyond absorbent inserts. The company also offers LivDry Ultimate incontinence underwear, with a maximum laboratory-tested absorbent capacity of 2,422 mL (81.9 oz), and LivDry EnduraDry Max tabbed briefs, with a maximum laboratory-tested absorbent capacity of 4,257 mL (143.9 oz).

LivDry EnduraDry Max tabbed briefs are designed for higher-demand situations where secure fit, easier changes and caregiver assistance may be especially important. The Hyper insert family provides an option for additional absorbency to be added to compatible protective underwear or briefs when protection needs increase.

Together, these products allow individuals and caregivers to consider more than absorbency capacity alone. LivDry's portfolio provides different combinations of capacity, comfort, fit, mobility, independence and caregiver accessibility, helping people choose a protection format that better matches how incontinence is managed in everyday life.
