

InventionHome® Product Developer Creates Stable, Accessible Platform for Gear in Tree Stands

PITTSBURGH, PA, UNITED STATES, August 25, 2026 /EINPresswire.com/ -- Louis R. of Gainesville, GA is the creator of the Stand Bench Rest, a portable tabletop platform designed to provide a stable and accessible surface for organizing equipment while seated in single or double tree stands. The device attaches directly to the stand's safety bar using multiple clamp points for creating a secured platform that can support commonly used gear.



The platform is configured similarly to a compact tray and is secured to the safety bar at four locations to distribute the load and improve stability. Brackets and clamps maintain the platform's position during use while allowing the device to be installed or removed without requiring permanent modification to the tree stand. The construction utilizes durable, noise-reducing plastic intended to limit unnecessary sound when equipment is placed on or moved across the platform. A camouflage configuration may also be used to reduce visual contrast with the surrounding environment.

Without a dedicated surface, hunters may need to continuously hold equipment which contributes to fatigue and discomfort. Frequently used items such as binoculars, gloves, mobile phones, wallets, and other accessories may also have to be stored in pockets or placed on limited surfaces, increasing the likelihood of misplaced or dropped equipment.

Key features and benefits include:

- Four-point attachment: Uses multiple brackets and clamps to secure the platform to a tree stand safety bar.
- Single- and double-stand compatibility: Designed for use with common single and double tree stand configurations.
- Improved organization: Provides accessible storage for binoculars, gloves, phones, wallets, and

other equipment.

- Camouflage option: Can be configured with camouflage coloring or patterns to reduce visibility against surrounding terrain.

The platform is suited to long hunting sessions in which maintaining a comfortable and stable position is important. Stand Bench Rest can reduce physical strain and provide easier access to frequently used items by transferring the weight of equipment from the user's hands to a secure platform.
