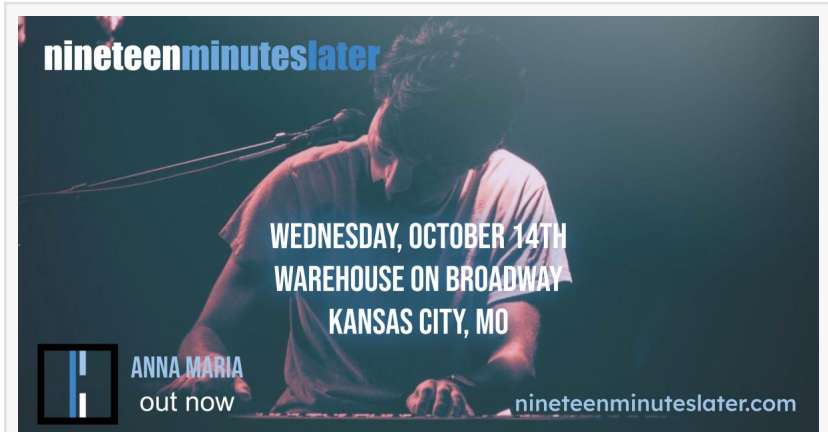


Nineteen Minutes Later Announces Pop Up Performance at Kansas City's Warehouse on Broadway

A Design Built for Comfort and a Community Centered Approach

In a July 21, 2025 article by [Nick Spacek](#) for The Pitch, Kansas City's independent source for news and culture, Partner and Founder Neill Smith emphasized that the venue isn't trying to compete with larger rooms like The Truman or The Granada:

"I'm just competing against Netflix and YouTube — and against shows that haven't made their way here. We want to bring back the kinds of tours that used to stop in Kansas City but now skip straight from Denver to Minneapolis."

The article highlights how Warehouse on Broadway has already become a second home for many locals. Smith notes that the venue's early success comes from listening closely to artists, guests, and staff — adjusting sound, stage layout, bar flow, and ticketing based on real time feedback. The goal has been to create a space that feels authentic, intimate, inclusive, and artist centered.

"It's not just about putting on shows," Smith says. "It's about fostering a creative culture and giving both performers and audiences something real to connect with."
