

Japanese Clothing Co Sets Out the Design and Production Process Behind Its T-Shirt Range

NORTH ENGLAND, UNITED KINGDOM, August 26, 2026 /EINPresswire.com/ -- Japanese Clothing Co, an online retailer specialising in Japanese-inspired T-shirts for men and women, has outlined how its designs are created and how orders are produced and checked before dispatch.

Designs are produced by hand. The company works exclusively with a group of artists who create each design using a mixture of digital and analogue tools, and states that no AI is used in the design of its products. Inspiration is drawn from across Japanese subcultures and traditions, from Harajuku street style through to manga and anime, and traditional arts including Nihonga painting and Shodo calligraphy.



Production runs on a made-to-order basis. Garments are printed once an order is placed, an approach the company says prevents wastage as a small business, and every item is assessed by a person before shipping rather than passing through an automated check alone.

Materials are selected with longevity in mind. The company says it uses heavyweight fabrics and carries out durability testing on new products before they are added to the store, working with suppliers whose materials retain print vibrancy and fabric softness through repeated washing. It positions the approach as a direct alternative to fast fashion.

The catalogue spans themes including cats and maneki neko, ramen, koi, dragons, samurai, ninja, kaiju, kawaii, vintage and vaporwave, with parallel collections for men and women. The [Japanese style t-shirts womens UK](#) range is organised by theme and colour to make browsing

easier.

The company was founded in the North of England by two Japanophiles following visits to Japan, and further background on its origins and approach is set out on its [About Us](#) page. Orders are shipped to customers in the UK, US and Europe.
