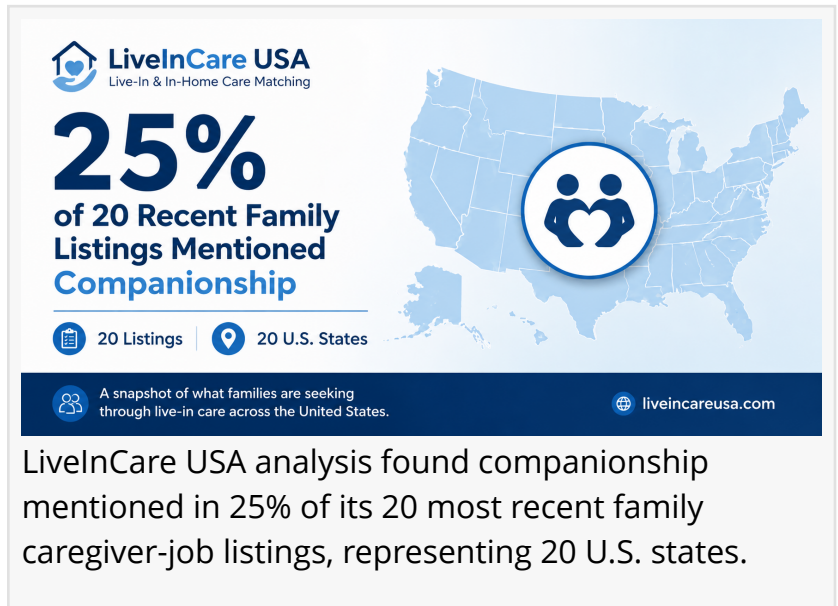


LiveInCare USA Analysis Finds Companionship in 25% of Recent Live-In Care Requests

A review of 20 recent family listings across 20 U.S. states shows companionship appearing alongside practical support and independence at home.

NEW YORK, NY, UNITED STATES, August 29, 2026 /EINPresswire.com/ -- [LiveInCare USA](#), an online care matching platform connecting families and live-in caregivers across the United States, analyzed its 20 most recent publicly visible [family caregiver-job listings](#) and found companionship emerging as a recurring part of what families are seeking from live-in care.



LiveInCare USA analysis found companionship mentioned in 25% of its 20 most recent family caregiver-job listings, representing 20 U.S. states.

Five of the 20 listings — 25% of the snapshot — prominently used the terms “companion” or “companionship.” Each of the 20 listings came from a different U.S. state, providing a geographically varied look at how families using the platform are describing their current care needs.

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Companionship stood out because families aren't always describing live-in care simply as a checklist of tasks.”

Alongside assistance with everyday activities, several families described needs related to maintaining independence, continuing familiar routines and remaining comfortably at home. The listings suggest that, for some families, the value of having a live-in caregiver extends beyond completing practical tasks to having another person consistently present in the home.

“What stood out in these recent listings is that families aren't always describing care simply as a checklist of tasks,” said Daniel Preston, founder of LiveInCare USA. “Companionship, having someone present and helping an older adult continue their normal life at home can be important parts of what a family is actually looking for.”

Live-in care arrangements differ considerably from one household to another. Some families are primarily looking for companionship and everyday household support, while others describe more extensive assistance needs. LiveInCare USA allows families to publish their individual requirements and connect directly with caregivers interested in [live-in and in-home care](#) opportunities.

The analysis is based solely on the 20 most recent family caregiver-job listings publicly visible on LiveInCare USA at the time of review. It is a descriptive snapshot of activity on the platform and is not intended to represent all U.S. families seeking live-in care.

LiveInCare USA plans to repeat and expand its analysis as its dataset grows, allowing future reports to examine larger samples, geographic differences and changes in the way families describe their care requirements.
