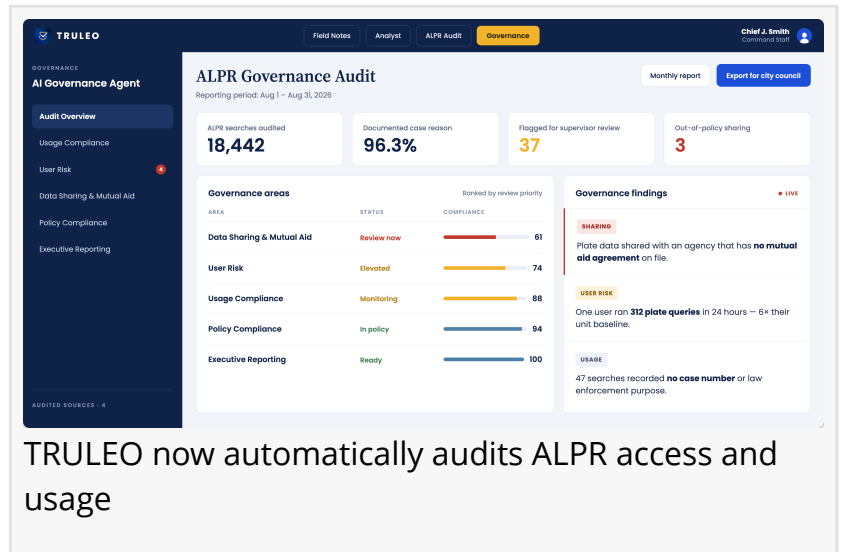


TRULEO Launches Auditor for License Plate Reader Programs

tool that automatically audits how law enforcement agencies access and use Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) systems, including Flock Safety and Axon camera networks.

The Governance Agent gives Chiefs, Sheriffs, command staff, and city leadership an independent layer of oversight over how their agencies use ALPR technology.

The launch comes as ALPR programs face growing public, political, and legislative scrutiny nationwide. Recent incidents involving alleged misuse of ALPR systems have increased pressure on law enforcement leaders to demonstrate that access to these powerful investigative tools is authorized, appropriate, and consistent with

agency policy.

At the same time, lawmakers in several states are considering measures that could increase the legal and regulatory consequences associated with improper ALPR access.

TRULEO developed the AI Governance Agent after multiple law enforcement customers

operating Flock camera networks approached the company with the same request: 'Give us an automated way to independently verify that ALPR access is appropriate without relying solely on the camera provider to audit its own system.'

The TRULEO AI Governance Agent was built directly in response to that demand.

"The company operating the camera network should not be the company telling the public whether that network is being used appropriately. Independent oversight protects officers, protects agencies, and ultimately strengthens public trust," says Anthony Tassone

Automated, Independent ALPR Governance.

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The TRULEO AI Governance Agent continuously analyzes ALPR access logs and helps command staff identify potential governance issues across five areas:

- Usage Compliance: Reviews ALPR searches and access patterns for consistency with authorized law enforcement purposes.
- User Risk: Identifies unusual or potentially higher-risk activity for supervisory review without automatically determining that misconduct occurred.
- Data Sharing & Mutual Aid: Reviews activity against agency-approved sharing practices and applicable mutual aid agreements.
- Policy Compliance: Helps determine whether ALPR usage aligns with departmental policies and established governance requirements.
- Executive Governance Reporting: Produces weekly, monthly, or quarterly reports that command staff can provide to city managers, city councils, oversight bodies, and elected officials as evidence of independent third-party review.

The result is a repeatable governance process that helps agencies answer an increasingly important question:

Who is independently auditing the use of your surveillance technology?

The Governance Agent is designed around emerging law enforcement best practices for responsible ALPR governance, including regular review of system access, usage, data sharing, and compliance with agency policy.
