

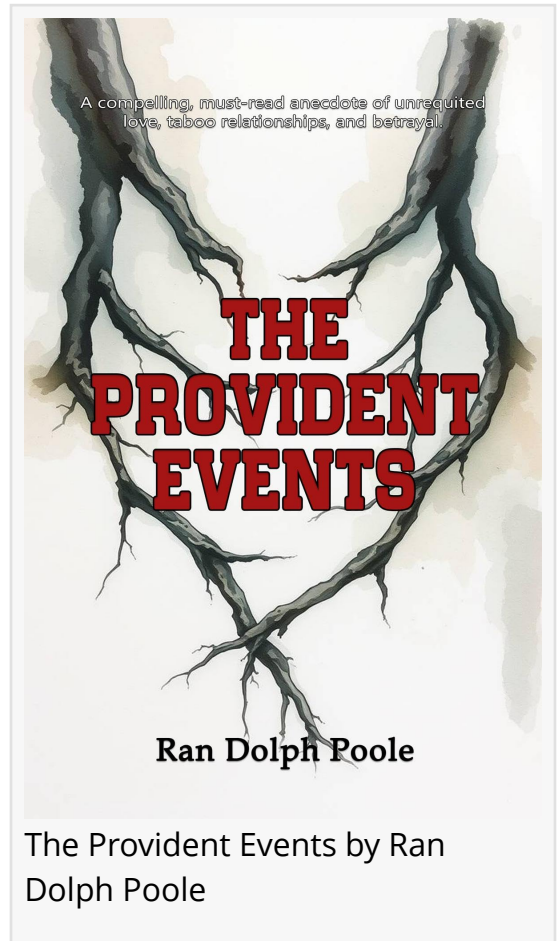
The Provident Events Explores Friendship, Betrayal, and the Secrets That Test Human Connection
