The company will also showcase its IntraMove autonomous mobile robot, which moves loads of up to 3,000 kg with autonomous navigation that adapts routes, avoids obstacles and adjusts to changing transport points without fixed infrastructure. The scalable system grows by adding robots, while integration with SynQ software enables seamless transport order management across the warehouse.
