Impact of Electronic Device Usage on Market Growth

For example, in May 2023, the Japan Electronics and Information Technology Industries Association reported that consumer electronics production in Japan reached \$204.67 million (¥32,099 million), an increase of 127% compared to the previous year. Such growth in electronic device usage directly contributes to higher demand for vision care solutions.

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Increasing Prevalence of Eye Disorders as a Growth Driver

The rising prevalence of eye disorders is another crucial driver for the vision care devices and equipment market. Eye disorders, which affect the structure or function of the eye, lead to visual impairment and discomfort, increasing the need for vision care products and treatments such as eyeglasses, contact lenses, and surgeries. According to a World Health Organization (WHO) report published in August 2023, at least 2.2 billion people globally suffer from near- or distance vision impairment. Of these, about 1 billion cases involve vision loss that could have been prevented or remains untreated. The main causes of distance vision impairment or blindness among these individuals include cataracts (94 million cases), refractive errors (88.4 million cases), age-related macular degeneration (8 million cases), glaucoma (7.7 million cases), and diabetic retinopathy (3.9 million cases). Presbyopia affects 826 million people and is the leading condition causing issues with close vision. This growing burden of eye disorders fuels demand for vision care devices and equipment.
