New fiber network brings speeds up to 2,500 Mbps to two more Southern Nevada communities

The new network will bring speeds up to 2,500 Mbps to 131 addresses across roughly 16 miles of new infrastructure, bridging the digital divide in two communities that have never had access to fiber internet before.

Construction is underway in both communities, with service becoming available in phases as work progresses. Full completion in both areas is expected before the end of 2026. The projects are supported in part by the Nevada State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLFRF).
