recognized pioneer of safety excellence and leadership strategies, announced that CEO [Shawn M. Galloway](#) presented the EHS Today webinar, “Eight-Armed Safety: Why EHS Leaders Must Think Like an Octopus, Not a Tin Man,” on Tuesday, Aug. 25. The session recording is now available on demand.

Many safety systems were built around standardization, centralized decision-making and compliance. While these remain important, today’s workplaces are increasingly complex and variable. When conditions change, overly rigid systems can struggle to respond.

During the webinar, Galloway introduces the Eight Arms framework, an approach for examining how well a safety strategy can learn and adapt. The framework focuses on eight interconnected areas: clarity, ownership, curiosity, experimentation, subcultures, learning architecture, spreading versus rolling out, and leadership.

Using the contrast between an octopus and the Tin Man, Galloway shows how leaders can recognize when their safety systems have become too mechanical and where greater adaptability is needed. Participants learn how to strengthen frontline ownership and organizational learning while preserving the practices and processes that already work.

Attendees leave with a practical way to evaluate their current safety strategy, identify where rigidity may be limiting performance, and determine where to focus improvement efforts over the next 90 days.
