

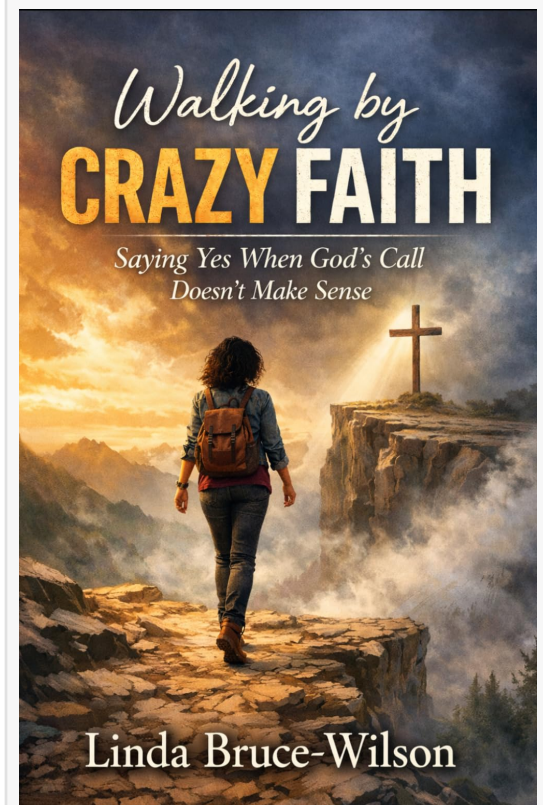
Walking By Crazy Faith Shows What Can Happen When Obedience Comes Before Understanding

Linda Bruce-Wilson shares a personal testimony of trusting God's direction through uncertainty, sacrifice, perseverance, and life-changing faith.

Her journey began in 2003, when she left California for Maryland after believing God had called her to go. With no job secured and no home waiting, Bruce-Wilson stepped away from familiar surroundings and relationships, beginning a journey that would test her faith and reshape her life.

In *Walking By Crazy Faith: Saying Yes When God's Call Doesn't Make Sense*, Bruce-Wilson recounts the challenges and changes that followed her move across the country. Her experiences include beginning again with limited possessions, adjusting to loneliness and uncertainty, becoming a Deacon shortly after arriving, and witnessing what she describes as God's provision and fulfilled promises. More than two decades later, she remains on the East Coast and continues teaching God's people. The memoir traces how sacrifice, perseverance, and obedience became defining elements of a decision that initially seemed difficult for others to understand.

Bruce-Wilson wrote *Walking By Crazy Faith: Saying Yes When God's Call Doesn't Make Sense* to share her testimony and remind others of God's faithfulness. She emphasizes that her idea of "crazy faith" is not about recklessness or making irrational choices. Instead, it describes moments when faith requires moving forward without having every answer or knowing how circumstances will unfold. Chapter 4 holds particular significance for Bruce-Wilson because it examines what

obedience looks like in practice, reinforcing the memoir's central message that faith can require action before the complete plan becomes visible.

The book is intended to encourage people standing at crossroads, facing uncertainty, questioning whether God is working behind the scenes, or struggling to believe that God is real. Through *Walking By Crazy Faith: Saying Yes When God's Call Doesn't Make Sense*, Bruce-Wilson hopes readers will recognize something of their own circumstances in her story and become encouraged to trust God more deeply. Her message asks readers to look beyond the title and consider a journey shaped by challenges, spiritual growth, perseverance, and the conviction that an unclear path does not mean God is absent.

Linda Bruce-Wilson presents her experiences not simply as a record of what happened to her, but as a testimony intended to strengthen others. Her journey from California to Maryland became an expression of the faith she continues to practice and teach today. At the heart of *Walking By Crazy Faith: Saying Yes When God's Call Doesn't Make Sense* is a message Bruce-Wilson considers universal: People can trust God even when they cannot see what comes next. She hopes her story inspires readers to find courage for their own step of faith.
