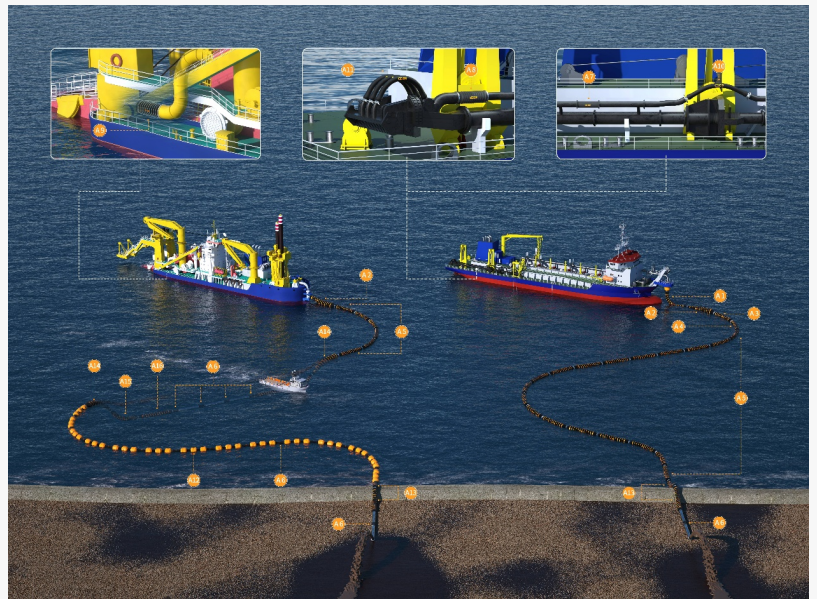


China Leading Oil Suction And Discharge Hose Supplier Showcases Innovation at OTC
