Sunshine State Award-winning report highlighted Central Florida veterans using Decision Tactical to reconnect, build confidence and navigate PTSD triggers.

The April 2025 report, "[Central Florida veterans share struggles with PTSD](#)," by Spectrum News 13 reporter Asher Wildman, followed Army veterans Kevin Steinmann and Paul Mason as they spoke candidly about living with post-traumatic stress disorder and their experiences using immersive scenarios at Decision Tactical. The Society of Professional Journalists recognized Wildman's report, entered as "Vets Try New Methods To Cope with PTSD," with First Place in the Television and Video Health Reporting category at the 2026 Sunshine State Awards.

For Decision Tactical, the recognition also brings renewed attention to work that extends beyond professional training: creating an environment where veterans can come together and challenge themselves alongside people who understand their experiences.

"Kevin and Paul were willing to be incredibly open about something many veterans carry quietly," said Remo Eyal, CEO and Co-Founder of Decision Tactical. "We are proud that Decision Tactical could provide a setting where they felt comfortable challenging themselves together, but this story has always been about them and the larger veteran community. Seeing their experiences recognized through this award gives an important conversation about PTSD another opportunity to be heard."

In the original Spectrum News 13 report, Steinmann described becoming better able to function around sounds and environments that had previously caused fear after spending time at Decision Tactical. Mason similarly spoke about the value he saw in participating alongside other veterans and reconnecting socially. The report also included insights from the Orlando VA's PTSD Trauma Team about established PTSD treatments and the potential benefits of social connection for veterans.

Decision Tactical is not a gun range or shooting attraction. Its 43,000-square-foot Sanford facility was built around decision readiness, using immersive environments, movement, communication and pressure-based scenarios to challenge how participants assess situations and respond. The facility serves civilians, corporate groups, law enforcement and other public safety professionals.

That focus on preparedness has also created opportunities for Decision Tactical to engage Central Florida's veteran community. In addition to the veterans highlighted in Wildman's report, Decision Tactical has previously hosted veteran-focused programming designed to bring former service members and their families together.

"Veterans understand better than most what it means to make decisions under pressure," Eyal said. "Our role is not to replace therapy or clinical care. What we can provide is a place for people to engage, work through scenarios together and leave feeling more connected and prepared than when they came in."

The award-winning Spectrum News 13 report continues to highlight a broader conversation around the challenges veterans can face when transitioning into civilian life and the importance of finding multiple forms of support, community, and connection.
