

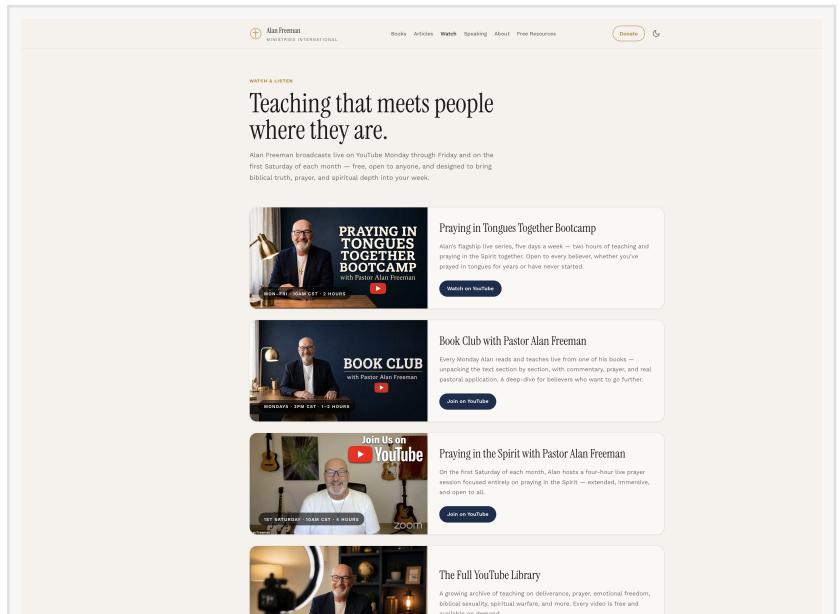
Alan Freeman Ministries International Launches Newly Expanded Website

Expanded site brings together 40+ years of pastoral ministry, five Christian books, free YouTube broadcasts and Bible teaching for a worldwide audience.

MANCHESTER, UNITED KINGDOM, September 4, 2026 /EINPresswire.com/ -- [Alan Freeman Ministries International](#) (AFMI), a UK-based Christian teaching and speaking ministry serving a worldwide audience, has launched a newly expanded website at [AFMI.co.uk](#), bringing together more than four decades of Pastor Alan Freeman's ministry, books, Bible teaching, live prayer broadcasts and free Christian resources in one online destination.

The expanded website introduces Freeman as a pastor, Christian author, Bible teacher and international speaker and organizes his growing body of work around areas central to his ministry: biblical deliverance and spiritual warfare, praying in tongues and life in the Holy Spirit, forgiveness and emotional resilience, and biblical teaching on sexuality, holiness and identity.

Although based in Manchester, United Kingdom, AFMI operates worldwide. The United States is currently the ministry's largest audience across YouTube, Amazon and website traffic, while Freeman's books and online teaching reach believers internationally.

"The new website brings together what I've learned over more than forty years of ministry so people can find biblical help for the struggles they are actually facing and know where to begin," Freeman said.

The site creates a new central home for Alan Freeman's Christian books, with five published titles addressing different areas of Christian life. Unbothered focuses on forgiveness, resentment, past hurts and emotional freedom. The Spiritual Deep Clean presents Freeman's practical biblical approach to deliverance, spiritual oppression, spiritual warfare and lasting freedom. Your Heavenly Superpower explores speaking in tongues, praying in the Spirit and developing a stronger prayer life.

Freeman's book Sexuality: What The Church Should Be Telling You But Is Too Afraid To Say addresses sexuality, same-sex attraction, pornography, marriage, temptation, restoration and identity from his biblical perspective. His illustrated children's book, The Pigs (with a spanish translation version called Los Cerdos), tells a story about grace, transformation and the Father's love.

The newly expanded site also connects visitors directly with [live YouTube teaching and prayer broadcasts](#) from Freeman. AFMI's YouTube community has grown to more than 86,700 subscribers, with hundreds of free videos covering deliverance, spiritual warfare, prayer, emotional freedom, forgiveness, biblical sexuality and Spirit-filled Christian living.

Freeman's flagship Praying in Tongues Together Bootcamp broadcasts for two hours Monday through Friday, combining Bible teaching with extended praying in the Spirit. He also hosts a weekly live Book Club, teaching through his published books in depth, and a four-hour Praying in the Spirit broadcast on the first Saturday of each month. The broadcasts are free and open to viewers worldwide.

The expanded Alan Freeman Ministries International website further provides a free 40-Day Prayer Challenge, an expanding article and teaching library, on-demand videos and a speaking section for churches, conferences and ministry events. Its structure is designed to help visitors move more easily from a question or struggle to relevant biblical teaching, a book, a free resource or ongoing ministry content.

Freeman's ministry background extends well beyond publishing and online broadcasting. He founded and pastored Christ Church 4U in Manchester for more than a decade and now serves in a position of oversight as the founding pastor. His pastoral calling was publicly commissioned when he was ordained by the late Dennis Wrigley, founder of the international Maranatha Community. Freeman's background also includes counseling training, seven years with Greater Manchester Probation Service and service in social care and chaplaincy with The Salvation Army.

Over more than 40 years, his ministry has included street evangelism, pastoral leadership, deliverance ministry, prayer, work with people facing addiction and homelessness, ministry among refugees and international speaking. Freeman founded Alan Freeman Ministries International in 2024 to focus on writing, broadcasting, teaching and equipping believers worldwide.

The newly expanded AFMI.co.uk website now reflects that broader body of work and provides one central destination for readers, viewers, churches and believers seeking Freeman's books, teaching, prayer resources and speaking ministry.
